

If the emergency is life threatening, dial 911 from your cell or any campus phone.

Remember, in the event of a fire, pull the alarm and evacuate the building immediately!

After providing information to the 911 Dispatcher, refer to the following, based upon the type of emergency/incident:

<u>Type of Emergency</u>	<u>Who to Call</u>	<u>What to Do</u>
Medical	1.) 911 if life threatening, otherwise: 2.) 660-2600 (On Duty Physical Plant)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stay in Place• If possible, send another person to meet rescue personnel
Campus Threat	1.) 911 if in imminent danger, otherwise: 2.) 453-5700 (ERT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Quickly assess the situation• Determine who to call
Bomb Threat	1.) 911 2.) 453-5700 (ERT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen for evacuation orders
Chemical Spill	1.) 453-5700 (ERT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Quickly assess the situation• If the spill is in your area, shut the windows, exit the room & shut the door

When calling emergency numbers, call from the emergency location if safe to do so
